In addition, our relationship with Metropolitan Golf Links is strong and growing. Together, we created a five-hole mini-course where students have the opportunity to learn the game from start to finish.

We are extremely proud to report that our chapter met its fundraising goal of \$500,000 through a combination of golf tournaments, corporate partnerships, grants awarded and individual donations from our community. We have an engaged Board of Directors that is rooted in and reflective of the Oakland community we serve. The Board also made significant personal financial contributions to our chapter.
