



A heartfelt *thank you* for your support as we continue to build a strong and sustainable First Tee-Oakland.

2024 was a significant growth year for our chapter. We delivered our Life Skills Curriculum to over 350 students at Metropolitan Golf Links and reached more than 2,800 students with our on-campus events. These numbers represent tremendous gains over 2023 when we served 200 students with our Life Skills Curriculum and 1,100 via outreach. The enthusiasm of our students, who come from Oakland Unified School District's (OUSD) after-school programs at Greenleaf Elementary and Middle Schools, Elmhurst Academy, Cox Academy, Laurel Elementary, East Oakland Pride and United for Success Academy, is the fuel that keeps us going. Coupled with the generosity and commitment of our funders, we provide world class programming plus transportation to and from the golf course **free of charge**. Of note, we are the only First Tee chapter in the nation that has free programming for all students.

The experience we create extends beyond golf and life skills. Our students are inspired by a team of passionate coaches and volunteers who bring the First Tee curriculum to life, demonstrating their love for the game while modeling the valuable lessons that can be learned on the course.

Our coaches and volunteers are the foundation of the First Tee-

Oakland experience. But we could not do what we do without Metropolitan Golf Links, a partner that consistently exceeds expectations. Together in 2024, we created a five-hole mini-course where students can learn the game from start to finish.

We are proud to report that our chapter met its fundraising goal of \$500,000 for a third consecutive year through a combination of golf tournaments, corporate partnerships, grants and individual donations. Big thanks to our highly engaged Board of Directors, a group rooted in and reflective of the Oakland community we serve, for their meaningful contributions to our chapter in terms of time and funding.

Building on 2024's momentum, we plan to serve 400 students through our Life Skills Program and aim for 3,500 through on-campus classes and events.

2024 has been an incredible year, and the First Tee-Oakland chapter is ready to set a new "course record" in 2025! Thank you for sharing our passion and helping us "Build GAME CHANGERS!"
